

## Other reviews of resources

It is useful to compare both the content of your evaluations and the criteria you used to judge a resource with those of other teachers. If you decide to do this, the following links will be useful.

1. The DfEE [TeacherNet](#) site contains reviewed material linked to its schemes of work.
2. The [BECTa](#) has a software review database for curriculum subjects.
3. The [Teachers Resource Exchange](#) of the [Virtual Teachers' Centre](#) contains a growing list of reviews of sites for curriculum subjects - but note that it does not clearly distinguish between learning and using IT.
4. [TEEM](#) (Teachers Evaluating Educational Multimedia) contains regularly updated reviews of web resource and CD-ROMs.
5. The BBC [WebGuide](#) pages contain reviewed resources for teaching ICT at all ages.

There are numerous other sites that you could look at for reviewed material - such as the excellent Guardian site [Learn.co.uk](#) and those for and by IT teachers of KS3/4 pupils (see the GCSE section of the course's Resources web page).
